

6. Graduation

Aim

- To enable Grade 12 students to have a successful Graduation ceremony, to mark the end of their time at Wales International School, in a celebratory manner.

Cross reference

- This policy follows ADEC Policy 49 of The Private Schools Policy and Guidance Manual.
- This policy corresponds to Article (54) of the Organising Regulations.

Procedure

Wales International School will conduct a Graduation Ceremony at the end of Grade 12 only (and will not be applicable to Al Ansar School until at least 2023)

The School Events Committee will lead the organisation of the Graduation Ceremony, which will take place in the School Auditorium during the evening on a date after the final A2 Level and MOE exam.

Wales International School shall consider religious, cultural and social norms of the UAE and the morals, customs and traditions of UAE society, when conducting the Graduation Ceremony.

Wales International School will not profit from Graduation and will accommodate the ceremonial cost within its annual budget. Students may make a floral or decorative contribution should they wish to do so, but this is voluntary.

School leaders and teachers will be present during the Graduation Ceremony as will the School Nurse. Should the Ceremony exceed 300 guests then we would ask for Community Police and the Paramedics to attend the event also.
